To All Members

I just wanted to update everyone on the flooding situation.

As of right now, here is what I know to be true:

1. Water levels in Bala are continuing to rise.
2. The Township dock is underwater.
3. There is a 40% chance of rain tonight. There is no rain presently forecast for Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday - but that can change very quickly these days.
4. Most of the logs in the North and South Dams in Bala have been removed by MNR.
5. OPG have removed logs from 6 of the 8 sluices at the Moon Dam. I do not know about what has taken place at Ragged Rapids Generator.
6. The Moon Chutes should be avoided due to heavy current and a significant drop in water from top to bottom. See picture shot 30 minutes ago.
