WATER QUALITY TESTING

The **MRPOA Aqua Man, Bruno Polewski**, and his crew, will be out on the Moon again this year taking samples for the Muskoka Lakes Association's water testing program. The program this year will consist of 4 weekends of testing, at 10 Moon River sites. In 2011, the MLA program biologists increased the number of samples at each site (adding phosphorous to the bacteria and turbidity) as well as sample locations (from 8 to 10). To partially offset this extra work, they reduced the number of sampling weekends from 8 to 4.

Sampling will start on the Victoria Day weekend, and end on the last weekend in August. The gathering of samples at the ten sites takes about an hour. If you are interested in helping as a water sampling volunteer, please contact Bruno at 905-818-5518, or by email at bruno1694@hotmail.com.

The **Moon River Water Quality Testing** results for 2011 continued to indicate excellent water quality at the ten sites. In 2010, there was some elevation in total coli forms and e-coli in two of the bays, but they were all below the MLA limits in 2011.

MOON RIVER COTTAGER DONATES \$3,300 IN RADIO CONTEST WINNINGS TO SAVE THE BALA FALLS

Long-time Moon River cottager and MRPOA Board Member, **Deborah Ylanko**, was a contestant on Toronto radio station *CHFI's Big Bag of Cash* contest, in which she won \$3,300. Deb told the show's co-hosts that she would be turning her winnings over to the **Save the Bala Falls** group.

Here's why she donated the money:

"It doesn't make sense to blast up Bala, ruin the Falls, all for energy that would be produced at the time of the year that we don't have the demand for it in Ontario. The only time significant amounts of energy would be generated from this project would be during periods of high run-off such as spring and fall. However, Ontario already has an abundance of energy during the spring and fall.

In the summer, when we do need power in Ontario due to air conditioning use etc., the proposed plant would **not** be able to produce much energy because there is not enough water flowing through Bala to make hydro electricity.

The power from the proposed hydro plant would not be used locally; it would go onto the grid. All Ontario residents will pay a private company vastly inflated prices for the power."
